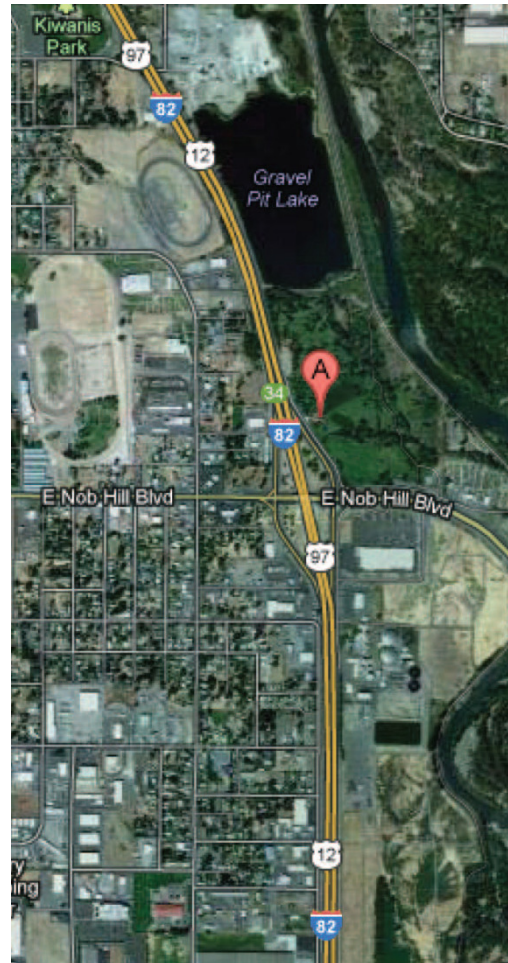
Directions & Parking
