Manager of Landfill Operations Course and Certification Exam

ABOUT THE COURSE & CERTIFICATION

The Manager of Landfill Operation (MOLO) course is a three day class. A three hour exam will be provided on the fourth day. It is necessary to pass the exam to be certified. This certification meets the Washington state requirements for a certified landfill operator or inspector. Those who are already certified may take the course to obtain 30 certification education units (CEUs) and apply for re-certification. It is not necessary to take the course before taking the exam; however, it is highly recommended.

The MOLO course provides a comprehensive study of efficient landfill operations, including site design, compliance with regulations, and issues to consider when planning, operating, and closing landfills.

This course does not include any field exercises and does not include a site visit to a landfill.

Breakfast and lunch are included in the course fees.
